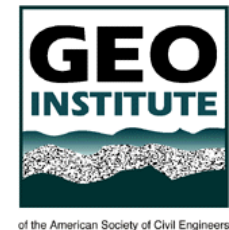
Liquefaction-induced Building

Abstract

Professor Tokimatsu oversees the Center for Urban Earthquake Engineering (CUEE), Tokyo Tech, as its Director, and leads the Global Center of Excellence (G-COE) Program entitled "International Urban Earthquake Engineering Center for Mitigating Seismic Mega Risk" sponsored by the Japan Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT). His research area lies principally in geotechnical earthquake engineering with concentration on liquefaction and its remediation, seismic soil-pile structure interaction, and geophysical exploration using surface waves including microtremors for site characterization.
